Re: Cherry Street closure and Lake Shore Boulevard sidewalk closure

Good afternoon –

I wanted to touch base to let you know that the closure of Cherry Street and re-routing of the pedestrians and cyclists to the south side of Lake Shore Boulevard East has been scheduled for Monday, October 31, 2011.

The closure will be in place for approximately two months to facilitate construction of the Cherry Street tunnel portion of the West Don Lands stormwater management system.

The location and details of the closure remain the same. Signage was installed at strategic locations last week to advise residents and drivers of the closure. The signage will remain in place for the duration of the work.

The work also requires the closure of the sidewalk along the north side of Lake Shore Boulevard East between Cherry Street and Parliament Street. The Don Valley Trail will be re-routed for cyclist and pedestrian safety. Cyclists and pedestrians will be directed to the south side of Lake Shore Boulevard.

A copy of the Cherry Street closure and trail detour map is attached for reference, distribution and posting.

Please remind your constituent groups that there is a lot of ongoing construction activity in the area, so it is necessary to exercise caution. Thank you for your continued patience as we construct this vital infrastructure.
