



## **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Northbound Lane closure on Cherry Street from Lake Shore Boulevard to the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor**

The northbound lane of Cherry Street is being temporarily re-opened, effective December 23, 2015 until mid-January 2016.

Construction of the sanitary forcemain is nearly complete. The northbound lane of Cherry Street has now been backfilled and paved, with the exception of a small section just north of the rail corridor that has received a temporary surface as this is the access point to complete the connection of the forcemain to the existing sanitary sewer. In order to avoid existing utilities in the area, it was necessary to reconfigure the means of connecting to the sewer and a dewatering process is now required.

Subject to receiving the necessary permits from the City of Toronto to discharge the surplus groundwater into the municipal sewer system, we expect that the work will recommence in mid-January, at which time this section of roadway will again be closed for an approximate two week period.

**Please note that the Cherry Street 172 bus detour remains in effect.**
