Building a world class street

The revitalization of Queens Quay is about much more than rebuilding the road – aging infrastructure will also be upgraded as part of this project. Waterfront Toronto is leading a coordinated effort that aims to streamline construction and avoid the need for more construction after the job is done. When complete, the new Queens Quay will be a completely upgraded, world-class waterfront street.
