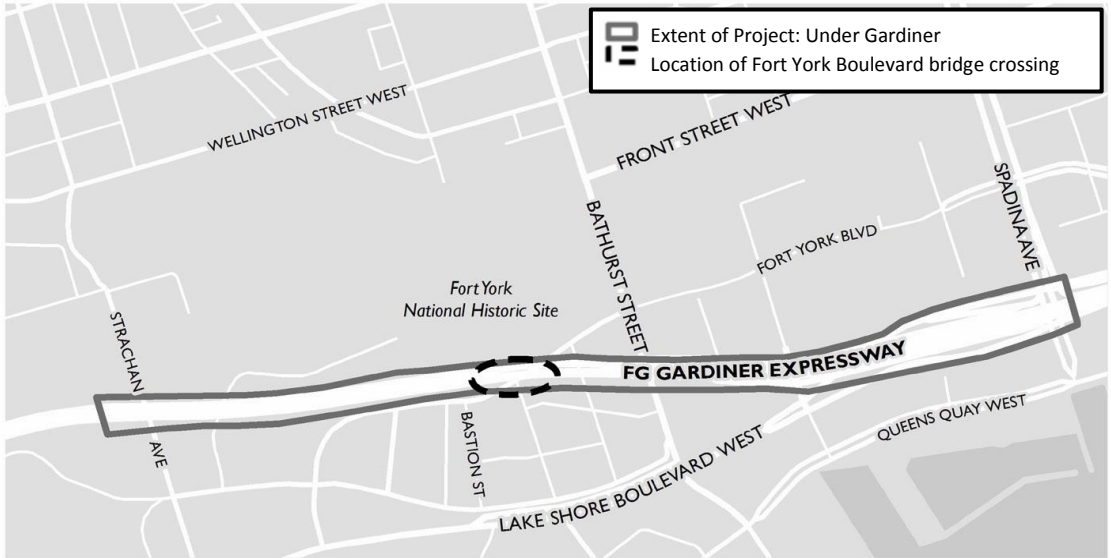


**PROJECT: UNDER GARDINER – PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLING
BRIDGE CROSSING, FORT YORK BOULEVARD
CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT – SCHEDULE C
NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT**

Waterfront Toronto and the City of Toronto are proposing to construct a pedestrian and cycling bridge to create a safe connection across Fort York Boulevard, underneath the Gardiner Expressway. The bridge crossing is part of The Bentway (formerly Project: Under Gardiner) which includes 1.75 kilometres of public space located beneath the Gardiner Expressway from Strachan Avenue to Spadina Avenue.



The bridge has been planned under **Schedule C** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**. The Environmental Study Report has been completed and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for review and comment. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, the City of Toronto and Waterfront Toronto intend to proceed with the detailed design and construction of this project once funding is secured. The estimated cost is \$6 million.

Interested persons should provide written comments to the City and Waterfront Toronto on the proposed bridge crossing within 30 calendar days from the date of this Notice (deadline for comments is: February 17, 2017).
