

Public Forum: Marine Strategy Study

Toronto's Waterfront

Boating and other water-based activities are an important part of the revitalization of Toronto's waterfront. The Toronto Waterfront Revitalization Corporation has a process underway to develop a Marine Strategy to ensure that these activities are effectively integrated into the work that the corporation is carrying out. The strategy will address the range of issues affecting all of the water-based users and make recommendations on how these issues can be addressed in the context of the overall revitalization plan.

Key elements of the strategy will include:

- Documenting the existing inventory of marine users, facilities, programs and events
- A strategy to optimize the use of existing marine infrastructure
- A market study to assess the demand for marine facilities in the future
- Recommendations regarding the location and facility needs of marine users
- Recommendations to ensure that the needs of marine users are addressed in other waterfront revitalization and planning initiatives
