CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #8: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)

For the two-week period from December 8 to 19, 2014

PROJECT SCOPE

The construction of a new Martin Goodman Trail and sidewalk on the south side of Queens Quay is progressing well. The majority of the demolition work has been completed (except for a few areas within driveways/intersections.) The concrete sidewalk has been completed between Small Street and Lakeshore Blvd. and is nearly complete between Dockside Drive and Small Street. The Martin Goodman Trail is nearly complete between Bonnycastle Street and the existing eastern end of the Martin Goodman Trail. Remaining asphalt work on the trail is expected to be complete by the end of the year. Final landscaping work and tree planting will occur in the spring.

Over the next two weeks, crews will be working as follows:

Zone 1 – Lower Jarvis Street to Dockside Drive:

Crews will install a new cast-in-place concrete curbs and sidewalk. Top soil placement will also be completed.

Zone 2 – Richardson Street to Bonnycastle Street

Crews will install asphalt paving for Martin Goodman Trail and complete installation of top soil.

Zone 3 – Bonnycastle Street to Small Street

No construction activities in this zone.

Zone 4 – Small Street to Parliament Street

No construction activities in this zone.

Zone 5 – Parliament Street & Lakeshore Boulevard crosswalk work

Crews expect to begin the construction of a new crosswalk along the east side of the Lakeshore Blvd/Parliament St. intersection. Crews will begin by removing the existing median island and guardrail so that a safe crosswalk can be installed.

Pedestrian, Cyclist and Vehicular Access

The eastbound curb lane will be closed to cyclist and vehicular traffic between Jarvis Street and Dockside Drive and Small Street and Parliament Street. Cyclists and vehicles will be required to share the remaining eastbound lane of traffic. Pedestrian access east of Lower Sherbourne to Lake Shore Blvd will be closed on the south side of Queens Quay, please use the north sidewalk in this area. Signage will be in place for any required pedestrian diversions.

Municipal Services Work

Municipal services work is underway to support new developments in East Bayfront including Bayside and Monde. The majority of work is occurring along Bonnycastle Street / Queens Quay East. The construction of new sewers on Queens Quay/Lake Shore from Bonnycastle to Cherry Street is expected to commence shortly. Traffic diversions will be required to accommodate the construction of the new sewers located within the road.
