

## SPECIAL QUEENS QUAY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

### Next Phase of Spadina Loop Construction Begins

Crews are preparing to begin the construction of 'Section C' of the Spadina Loop which is located on Queens Quay at the west entrance to the 390 Maple Leaf Quay/Shoppers Drug Mart laneway. Starting Tuesday, December 10, the west entrance and laneway will be closed to incoming and outgoing traffic to allow crews to undertake this work. Access to the 410 Condominium parking lot will not be impacted.

#### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

##### **Motor Vehicles**

Westbound traffic will be maintained on Queens Quay at all times. Traffic will be diverted slightly south around the construction zone.

Access to the Maple Leaf Quay/Shoppers Drug Mart parking lot will be from the east driveway (at the Beer Store entrance). The west driveway entrance/laneway will be closed.

##### **Pedestrians**

East/west pedestrian access along the north side of Queens Quay will be maintained at all times in front of Maple Leaf Quay and Shoppers Drug Mart.

##### **Transit**

The 509 Harbourfront bus and 510 Spadina bus service will remain as it is now.

##### **Cyclists**

Access to the detour bike route – an asphalt trail located in the boulevard area on the south side of Lake Shore Blvd. between Lower Spadina Ave. and York St. – will be maintained.

##### **Night Work**

TTC crews may work overnight when moving and installing track.

#### **TIMING**

The reconstruction of the Spadina Loop is well underway. This important piece of TTC infrastructure allows both the 509 and 510 streetcars to reverse direction. Section C is expected to be completed by late January at which point the west entrance to the 390 Queens Quay/ Shoppers Drug Mart will reopen. The entire reconstruction of the Spadina Loop is on schedule to be completed by February 2014.
