CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #21: Martin Goodman Trail Connection July 2, 2013 to July 5, 2013

Reminder: Monday, July 1 is Canada Day. There are no construction activities or crews working on this holiday.

The concrete sidewalk between Lower Jarvis Streets to the Pier27 Presentation Centre (east of Lower Yonge St) was completed and opened to the public, prior to the start of the busy summer events. Last week, construction crews were able to complete the remaining short section of curb and sidewalk from the Pier 27 Presentation Centre to the west side of Lower Yonge Street. This week, crews will complete the paving between curbs and sidewalks, and the restoration of this area. Once our construction activities are complete, the Martin Goodman Trail will officially open.

The infrastructure work for the new signalized intersection at Lower Sherbourne and Queens Quay East has been completed. Final line painting and hydro connections must occur before the signal can be made operational.

Pedestrian and Vehicle Access:

Two-way traffic will be maintained along Queens Quay, but some short term lane diversions may be required when crews are completing curbs, sidewalks, lane painting, and final detail landscape work. Traffic barrels will be used to mark these localized work areas and their progress along Queens Quay.

All driveways will be maintained during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the northside of Queens Quay with alternative diversion paths marked with signage.
