CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #2: Martin Goodman Trail Connection & Jarvis Slip Dock Wall Reinforcement Week of October 15th to October 19th, 2012

JARVIS DOCKWALL REINFORCEMENT

Somerville Construction crews continue to mobilize on site with fast fence erected around the work zone at the head of the Jarvis Slip. During the week of October 15, crews are expected to trench along the length of the Jarvis Slip Dock wall. This trench will allow crews to expose and examine the condition of the existing dock tie-backs.

Pedestrian and Vehicle Access:

The pedestrian path from Queens Quay to Sugar Beach has been closed with fast fence. Signage has been installed indicating that visitors to Sugar Beach may enter from the Dockside Drive entrance on the east side of the park.

Minor traffic and vehicle disruptions will occur as heavy machinery is brought to the site and positioned within the work zone and fast fence area.

- Jarvis Slip Dock Wall: Construction will begin on the reinforcement project
- Martin Goodman Trail Connection: Additional tender packages have now closed and will be awarded for this work
