Some Night Work

A short section of the Peter Slip Bridge, which is situated between the 350 and 390 Queens Quay West, has been prepared for the next stage of construction involving the installation of the streetcar rail.

Beginning on Tuesday, June 11 and continuing for approximately 5 days, TTC track crews will be installing the rail on the bridge. The work will include; installing the rails, welding the rails and installing the rail expansion joints.

Night Work

This installation will involve some night work by the TTC. While efforts will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum, noise will be evident when some equipment is in full operation.
