## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Jack Layton Ferry Terminal and Harbour Square Park**

Construction is scheduled to begin this fall on Phase 1A of the Jack Layton Ferry Terminal and Harbour Square Park project.

Beginning late-October to early-November, the western walkway that leads visitors to Harbour Square Park (located just west of the main entrance at Bay Street and Queens Quay) will close. This will allow us to install a widened asphalt walkway that will provide uninterrupted access to the terminal gates through construction of Phase 1A. Once the widened western walkway is installed and reopened for public access, the main walkway that runs south from Bay Street to the ferry terminal gates will close for construction. We expect this work to begin in early- to mid-November and the new main walkway to open for the season opening in May 2018.

City of Toronto staff will also be on site from now until early-November to remove items including park furnishings, planters, flag poles and pavers. As part of installing the new pedestrian promenade and the western walkway, the City will be removing 15 trees that are directly affected. These trees will be replaced by 16 new trees that will be planted using soil cell technology that will help ensure healthy growing conditions for the trees.
