CONSTRUCTION NOTICE 20: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)

Beginning last week, Waterfront Toronto resumed work on installing two stormwater forcemains along Queens Quay East from Bonnycastle Street to Parliament Street. This is the final piece of work in completing the areas overall storm water connections to the Cherry Street Stormwater facility.

In order to complete this work, east-west traffic has been reduced to one lane in each direction with the closure of the south side of Queens Quay East from Bonnycastle Street to Parliament Street. Clearway Construction Inc. will be on site between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday. Access to sidewalks and the Martin Goodman Trail will be maintained at all times. This work is expected to be completed by mid-May.

The construction crew will then complete a small piece of work on the south side of Queens Quay East at Merchant's Wharf. During this time, vehicular traffic will not be impacted but cyclists on the Martin Goodman Trail will be directed to dismount from their bicycles for safety measures. This final piece of work will take approximately two weeks and be completed by the end of May 2019.
