CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #14: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)

Municipal Services Work

Dewatering has now been completed from Bonnycastle Street to Small Street, drawing down the very high ground water table in this area to facilitate the installation of the deep sewer.

The next stage of work involves excavation. This will commence on **Monday, January 18**, starting at Bonnycastle Street and proceeding to the east. During this phase of construction, crews will need to adjust the fencing that is currently in place, barring east-west access along the north-side curb lane. Access to existing parking areas will be maintained. This excavation facilitates the installation of the sanitary sewer and storm sewer. Barring any delays due to unforeseen construction issues or severe weather conditions, this work is scheduled for completion in early April.

This construction occupies the northern part of Queens Quay. Two-way traffic has been rerouted to the southern part of the road. The fencing that is currently in place allows vehicles to access all businesses on the north side of Queens Quay. "Open for business" signs for businesses at 200 Queens Quay East have been affixed to the construction fencing.

The final stage of work will involve the installation of the storm forcemains from Small Street to Parliament Street. More details about this work will be circulated in a subsequent construction notice.
