The Toronto Waterfront Revitalization Corporation (TWRC), working closely with the City of Toronto, is now in the final stages of developing an implementation strategy for revitalizing the Port Lands – an approximately 400 hectare district bounded by the Keating Channel/Don River and Lakeshore Boulevard in the north, the Toronto Inner Harbour in the west, Ashbridges Bay in the east and Lake Ontario and Tommy Thompson Park in the south.
