CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #12: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Municipal Services Work

Crews have temporarily halted work on the sanitary trunk sewer from Bonnycastle Street to Small Street. This work was expected to be complete by early December. However, complications have arisen that have forced crews to temporarily stop work at this location.

The construction occupies the northern part of Queens Quay. Two-way traffic has been rerouted to the southern part of the road. The fencing that is currently in place allows vehicles to access all businesses on the north side of Queens Quay. "Open for business" signs for businesses at 200 Queens Quay East have been affixed to the construction fencing.

When work resumes, excavation will start at Bonnycastle Street and proceed to the east. During this phase of construction, crews may need to adjust the fencing that is currently in place. Before making any changes, we will consult with all businesses that may be affected.

A new project schedule will be shared as soon as it becomes available.
