## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #15: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)**

### *Municipal Services Work*

Work on the deep sanitary trunk sewer on Queens Quay East from Bonnycastle Street to Small Street is complete. The installation of the storm sewer from Bonnycastle to 100 metres east of Bonnycastle is also complete. Excavation is now underway for the remaining section of storm sewer east to Small Street.

The final piece of work at this location involves installing two stormwater forcemains from Bonnycastle Street to Parliament Street. Crews have been unable to start this work due to the condition of an existing watermain on the site. This is the watermain that broke in January, causing a significant delay while City of Toronto and Waterfront Toronto crews shut down the water supply, pumped out water, removed saturated soil, repaired the watermain, backfilled and restored the area around the watermain, and then cleaned up the open trench for the storm and sanitary sewers so that work could resume. To expedite the completion of this work and remove the lane restrictions on Queens Quay, installation of these two stormwater forcemains will be deferred. This work will be included as part of the future development of Queens Quay, at which time the existing watermain will be relocated.

There is still some work to complete at the Bonnycastle and Queens Quay intersection over the next several weeks. Over the next few weeks, crews will be cleaning up and demobilizing the construction zone along Queens Quay between Bonnycastle Street and Small Street. Next week, we will also begin to narrow and shift the existing construction fencing in order to improve access for the public and local businesses.
