CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #13: Martin Goodman Trail Connection

April 29, 2013 to May 3, 2013

Over the next few weeks, Eastern Construction's sub-contractor —Coco Paving — will undertake remediation work on the concrete sidewalk between Lower Yonge and Lower Jarvis Streets. This work, which was identified as part of a standard Quality Control Plan review, is required to ensure the sidewalk meets the City and Waterfront Toronto's standards and specifications as set out in the contract. The sidewalk will open in May as planned.

What to Expect:

Last week, crews began demolition and removal of sidewalk segments along the southside of Queens Quay from east of Lower Yonge Street to Lower Jarvis Street. New concrete for these sidewalks will be poured beginning on Monday, April 29. Crews will start east of Lower Yonge Street and move east along Queens Quay to Lower Jarvis Street.

The section of sidewalk east of Freeland Street in front of the new Pier 27 condominiums will be poured once Rabcon Construction (sub-contractor to Cityzen and the City of Toronto) completes their site services work for the Phase 1 Pier27 building. This work will be scheduled and coordinated with Rabcon.

Some minor construction and equipment noise can be expected when this remediation work proceeds.

Pedestrian and Vehicle Access:

Two-way traffic will be maintained along Queens Quay, but short term lane diversions may be required when crews are working on the concrete sidewalks. Traffic barrels will be used to mark these localized work areas and their progress along Queens Quay.

All driveways will be maintained during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the northside of Queens Quay with alternative diversion paths marked with signage.

- Remediation of paving at the eastern driveway/entrance to Redpath.
- Remediation of bus layby at Lower Jarvis
