### **York Street Park and Rees Street Park Stakeholder Advisory Committee**

Waterfront Toronto is assembling a Stakeholder Advisory Committee (SAC) for York Street Park and Rees Street Park, two new waterfront parks that will be designed to respond to the pressing issues of a growing city, and a busy waterfront district that attracts millions of visitors annually. These will be parks that will serve the diverse needs of local residents, office workers and visitors, and aim to set new standards for inclusive design, sustainability, and climate resilience.

The SAC plays an important role in the public consultation process for the project by providing feedback, guidance and advice to the project team (Waterfront Toronto, the City of Toronto, the project designers, and key consultants) at key points during the design and implementation of the project.

We are seeking up to six individuals to volunteer to represent the community--at--large. We are specifically looking for folks who are willing and able to engage with and represent groups or communities with an interest in new waterfront public spaces, as well as individuals with experience advocating for active transportation (walking and cycling), accessibility, and a variety of recreational activities in parks and public spaces.

SAC members must be able to commit to attending up to **three (3)** meetings—generally taking place on **weekday evenings, two to three hours in length**—over the course of the next twelve months.
