Partial Intersection Closure: Spadina Ave. and Lake Shore Blvd. & Gardiner Eastbound Off-ramp

Spadina Avenue and Lake Shore Blvd. to King St. Project
Streetcar Track Reconstruction, Road Resurfacing, Watermain Replacement

Start: Thursday, February 14, 2013 at 10:30 a.m.
End: Sunday, February 17, 2013 at 6:00 a.m.

Major construction work will be carried out at the intersection of Lake Shore Boulevard and Spadina Avenue, and will require a partial intersection closure. It will also result in a partial closure to the Gardiner Expressway (eastbound) off-ramp at Spadina Avenue. Construction activities include streetcar electrical and structural works. We regret any inconvenience that may be caused as a result. *Note: The construction work in Construction Notice #7 was cancelled due to weather.*

Thursday, February 14 -- Vehicle Access

Spadina Avenue

- both directions: one lane straight through intersection will be open;
- South-bound: right-turn onto Gardiner Expressway/ Lake Shore Boulevard on-ramp will be open

Lake Shore Boulevard (eastbound)

- two lanes straight through intersection will be open

Gardiner Eastbound Off-ramp exit

- Open

Friday, February 15 to Sunday, February 17 -- Vehicle Access

Spadina Avenue

- North-bound: Both two lanes straight through intersection will be closed (alternates: Rees St, Lower Simcoe St)
- South-bound: one lane straight through intersection will be open;
- South-bound: right-turn onto Gardiner Expressway/ Lake Shore Boulevard on-ramp will be open

Lake Shore Boulevard (eastbound)

- One lane straight through intersection will be open

Gardiner Eastbound Off-ramp exit

- One south curb lane will be closed (alternate exits: Jameson, York-Bay-Yonge, Jarvis)

Pedestrian Access

- the east-west crosswalk at Lakeshore and Lower Spadina will be moved 5 metres south and will remain open at all times

Work Hours

Work hours are 9 a.m. to 6 a.m. (12 hour shifts plus extra hours when required). Construction at this intersection will involve overnight work and extended hours.

TTC Service (see map at right)

Replacement bus Service from King Street to Queens Quay Loop:

- will continue to operate, and
- North-bound buses will detour from Lake Shore Boulevard to Rees Street/Bremner Boulevard from February 14 – 17, 2013 at 6 a.m.

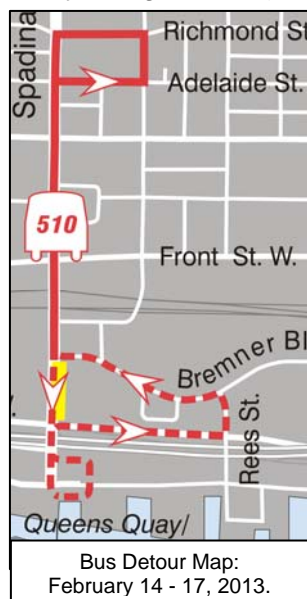
