## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #13: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)**

### **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

#### *Municipal Services Work*

Work on the sanitary trunk sewer from Bonnycastle Street to Small Street will resume on January 4, 2016. At this time, the dewatering system previously installed will be actuated, so that the very high ground water table in this area can be temporarily drawn down to facilitate the installation of the deep sewer.

It is expected that the draw down will take 1-2 weeks, after which excavation will commence starting at Bonnycastle Street and proceeding to the east. During this phase of construction, crews may need to adjust the fencing that is currently in place. Before making any changes, we will consult with all businesses that may be affected.

The construction occupies the northern part of Queens Quay. Two-way traffic has been rerouted to the southern part of the road. The fencing that is currently in place allows vehicles to access all businesses on the north side of Queens Quay. "Open for business" signs for businesses at 200 Queens Quay East have been affixed to the construction fencing.
