CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #11: Queens Quay East Interim Improvements (Lower Jarvis to Parliament)

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Municipal Services Work

Work continues on the sanitary trunk sewer from Bonnycastle Street and Queens Quay to the sewage pumping station in the east. This work is expected to be complete by early December. We will continue to issue regular construction notices while this work is underway.

Westbound lanes between Bonnycastle and Small will be closed for the duration of this work. The fencing that is currently in place allows vehicles to access all businesses on the north side of Queens Quay. "Open for business" signs customized for each unit at 200 Queens Quay East will be affixed to the construction fencing. During construction, crews may need to adjust the fencing that is currently in place. Before making any changes, we will consult with all businesses that may be affected.

Next week, crews will continue installing the dewatering system, which involves the use of a backhoe and a drill rig. The fencing that is currently in place will remain unchanged.

Pedestrian crossing at Parliament and Queens Quay

Line painting for the new pedestrian crossing at Parliament and Lake Shore is complete. Barriers will be removed once the pedestrian crossing signals have been installed.
