Date: Saturday, May 30

Time: 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Location: Meet in front of the main entrance (off Queens Quay West) of Queen's Quay Terminal, 207 Queens Quay West.

Closest major intersection: Queens Quay West and York Street

Public Transit: TTC subway station Union Station. Take the 509 Harbourfront streetcar or the 510 Spadina streetcar to Harbourfront Centre. Walk east on Queens Quay West towards York Street. Please use the TTC trip planner for additional options.

Parking: Paid parking is available nearby at Harbourfront Centre on Queens Quay West at Lower Simcoe Street. Other paid parking lots are available along Queens Quay, Lower Simcoe Street and Bay Street.

Accessibility: The site walk includes walking for an extended period of time along the 1.7km stretch of Queens Quay West using the pedestrian promenade. The site is wheelchair accessible.
