CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #9: York Street Park (*Love Park*)

Background

York Street Park (*Love Park*) will be a 2-acre park located at the southern foot of York Street and Queens Quay West in the southern Financial District and Harbourfront neighbourhood. Reclaimed as public space from its former use as the Gardiner's York-Bay-Yonge eastbound off-ramp, the park will be the ultimate ode to connection, community, and nature.

Updates

Weekend Construction

On Saturday, August 27, our contractor, Somerville Construction, will begin working on occasional Saturdays until the end of November. This weekend work will help to mitigate impacts and delays caused by labour disputes that occurred earlier this year and ongoing supply chain disruptions.

As per the City of Toronto's bylaw, construction work on Saturday will take place between the hours of 9am-7pm.

What to expect

- Moderate noise is expected.
- Construction vehicles will be active on-site.

Timeline

Due to ongoing supply chain issues and labour disputes that occurred earlier this year, the anticipated substantial completion of the project has been delayed to December 2022. To accommodate the necessary commissioning of the water feature, the park will be opened to the public in spring 2023.

Construction of York Street Park (*Love Park*) began in July 2021 with substantial completion anticipated by year-end 2022.
