Traffic Update

Lane Restrictions on the Don Valley Parkway On/Off Ramp to Lake Shore and Lake Shore Boulevard west of Don Roadway: September 2-6

Over the Labour Day long weekend, there will be lane closures around the Don Roadway/Don Valley Parkway intersection with Lake Shore Boulevard East:

The northbound lanes of the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) on-ramp from Lake Shore Boulevard East will be closed. Drivers will still be able to access the DVP at this location. Northbound traffic will be shifted into one of the southbound lanes, and southbound traffic will be restricted to one lane.

Two lanes of Lake Shore Boulevard will be closed west of the bridge over the Don River for approximately 100 metres. The remaining lane will serve alternating east and west traffic.

Traffic will be controlled by a flag person. This closure allows for utility work to be undertaken by Enbridge.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Lane reductions of the Don Valley Parkway on- and off-ramps to Lake Shore Boulevard East starting at 9:00 p.m. on Friday, September 2, until 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 6.
- Lake Shore Boulevard reduced to a single lane with alternating east and west traffic. The lane reductions will be in place west of the bridge over the Don River for approximately 100 metres, starting at 9:00 p.m. on Friday, September 2, until 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 6.
- Paid Duty Officers and flag persons will control traffic.

Rescheduled - Northbound Cherry Street temporarily closed between Commissioners Street and Unwin Avenue: September 09-12

The work on Cherry Street between Commissioners Street and Polson Street that was planned for the weekend of August 26-29 has been rescheduled to September 09-12. This work is to connect the new alignment of Cherry Street with the existing alignment at Polson Street. A more detailed reminder will be sent in advance of the work.

Rescheduled - Vehicular traffic on Cherry Street switching to new alignment between Polson Street and Commissioners Street: Starting September 12

To allow for excavation of the new mouth for the Don River, vehicular traffic will be re-routed onto the new alignment of Cherry Street between Polson Street and Commissioners Street, starting on Monday, September 12. A more detailed reminder will be sent in advance of the work.

Upcoming Work

Logan Avenue closed between Lake Shore Boulevard East and Commissioners Street: starting as early as September 19

For two weeks in mid-September, Logan Avenue will be closed south of Lake Shore Boulevard East to Commissioners Street for utility work. There will be no impact to lanes on Lake Shore Boulevard East. This work is part of the utility work flagged in Construction Notice 32 (<https://portlandsto.ca/wp-content/uploads/PLFP-LSBE-Construction-Notice-32-July-Final-2.pdf>).

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- No access to southbound Logan Avenue from Lake Shore Boulevard East
- Northbound traffic on Logan Avenue from Commissioners Street will be restricted to local traffic only. There will be no access to Lake Shore Boulevard via Logan Avenue.
- The Mayfair Racquet Club will be accessible via northbound Logan Avenue, coming from Commissioners Street. There will be no access to Lake Shore Boulevard East from Logan Avenue.

Road work on Saulter Street between Lake Shore Boulevard East and Commissioners Street: September – October 2022

Starting in September 2022, Saulter Street will be closed between Lake Shore Boulevard and Villiers Street due to road and utility work. There will also be lane closures between Villiers Street and

Commissioners Street. Work will take approximately 5-6 weeks and include excavation, ground compaction, and paving. The work may also create construction equipment noise and minor vibration. The cycling detour on Saulter Street between Villiers Street and Commissioners Street will be maintained. Access to the local business will be maintained during construction.

Ongoing Work

Update: Cherry Street and Lake Shore Boulevard Intersection

Cherry Street between Lake Shore Boulevard East and Mill Street is scheduled to reopen in fall 2022. Pedestrians and cyclists will continue to be able to access Lake Shore Boulevard East via Cherry Street during the remaining construction.
