CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #1: Queens Quay East Lakefill

Background

As part of the Quayside project, Waterfront Toronto will extend Queens Quay east to the planned Silo Street, including a new intersection with a realigned Parliament Street. The extension of Queens Quay East will support the future road network and potential light rail transit in the area. To facilitate this work, the head of Parliament Slip will be filled in and a new dockwall will be constructed.

Location

Area within and surrounding the Parliament Slip spanning from 3 Parliament Slip east to 333 Lakeshore Boulevard East and South to the waterfront.

What to expect

On August 1, 2023, the construction team will begin using the parking lot at 333 Lake Shore Boulevard (on the east side of Parliament Slip) for staging and general site mobilization. Construction of the new dockwall and lakefill will begin in Fall 2023.

Land side activity:

- 333 Lake Shore Blvd.: construction vehicle transit, stock piling, soil management, equipment, storage, trailer compound, fencing, signage, general site cleanup, surveying, and site investigation works.
- Tree removal
- Truck traffic
- Flagmen: supporting pedestrian and cyclist safety on Martin Goodman Trail

Water side activity:

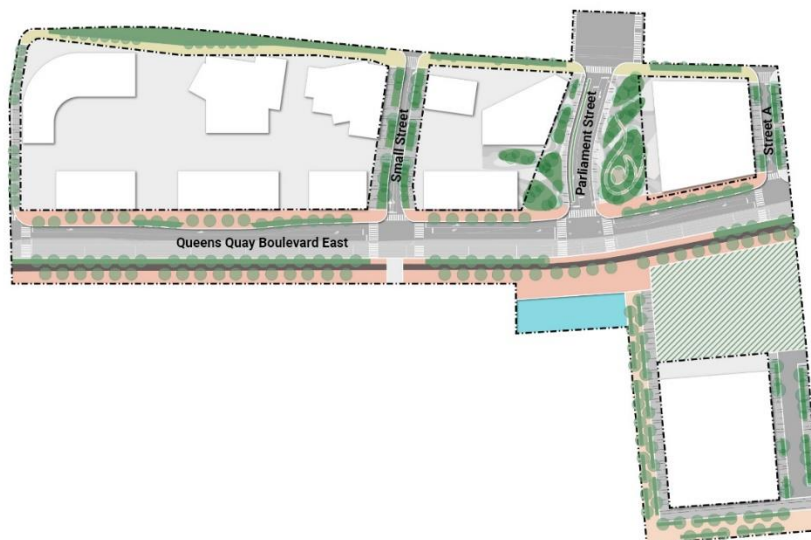
- Barge located within the Slip
- Turbidity curtain, oil boom & environmental liners to control debris and sediment during construction, ensuring water quality, and health of aquatic animals and vegetation.
- Dredging
- Lakefilling
- Dockwall installation work
- Rockberm construction

Waterfront Toronto will continue to provide construction updates as work progresses.

Timeline

- **August 2023:** Construction mobilization
- **Fall 2023-January 2025:** Construction of new dockwall and lakefill
