CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #3: Legacy Art Project Toronto

Background

The Legacy Art Project is a public space dedicated to the spirit of courage, determination, and action that Terry Fox embodied.


The project design titled, 'We Are Shaped by the Obstacles We Face,' was conceived by artist Jon Sasaki and landscape architects DTAH during a nationwide call for proposals by Legacy Art Project Toronto in collaboration with Art+Public.

Located on Queens Quay West, east of the Toronto Music Garden, along the Martin Goodman Trail, construction of the Legacy Art Project began in July 2023, with estimated completion in fall 2023.

The park is made possible by individual donors, the Government of Canada through the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario, the City of Toronto, and the Waterfront Business Improvement Area (BIA). Waterfront Toronto is the project manager and a key partner.

Update

Temporary Eastbound Road Closure



A temporary closure of the eastbound vehicle lanes on Queens Quay West between Dan Leckie Way and Spadina Avenue will be required on Wednesday, September 13 from 7:00.am until 7:00 pm to install the granite slabs which will form the Legacy Art Project. A crane will be erected on-site to facilitate the granite installation.

This work will also temporarily close the southern sidewalk on Queens Quay West and the Martin Goodman Trail between WEST Dan Leckie Way and Spadina Avenue.

A paid duty officer or flag person will be present at both intersections to help direct traffic during the temporary closure and facilitate access to Marina Quay West.

An earlier reopening of the effected routes may occur if the granite installation is completed before 7:00 pm.

What to expect

For vehicles

- Vehicles travelling east bound will be detoured north up Dan Leckie Way to Lakeshore Boulevard West to continue east bound towards Spadina Avenue, where they can turn right on Spadina Avenue and then left on Queens Quay West to continue east.
- South bound vehicles on Dan Leckie Way will not be able to turn left onto Queens Quay West.

For cyclists

1. Cyclists travelling east bound on the Martin Goodman Trail will need to dismount at Dan Leckie and will be routed to the waterfront trail where they can continue walking eastbound and then north on the waterfront trail to connect back to the Martin Goodman Trail at Spadina Avenue.
2. Cyclists travelling west bound on the Martin Goodman Trail will need to dismount at Spadina Avenue and will be routed to the waterfront trail where they can continue walking south towards the waterfront trail and then west bound on the waterfront trail until it connects to the Martin Goodman Trail at Dan Leckie Way.

For pedestrians

3. Pedestrians will be directed to walk on the north side of Queens Quay West to travel east/west on Queens Quay West.

Accessing Marina Quay West

- A paid duty officer or flag person will be on-site to facilitate access to Marina Quay West.
- East bound access on Queens Quay West will be given to vehicles needing to access Marina Quay West.
- For vehicles leaving Marina Quay West, intermittent access will be provided to use the eastbound lane on Queens Quay West to travel westbound towards Dan Leckie Way.
- Those accessing the Marina Quay West will not be given access to travel east bound on Queens Quay West past the Marina entrance.
