Broadview and Eastern Flood Protection

Traffic and Construction Notice

Lane Closure at Eastern Avenue and Broadview Avenue to Occur this Fall

Beginning **as early as late September**, the south curb lane of eastbound Eastern Avenue at Broadview Avenue will be closed to support watermain construction as part of the Broadview Eastern Flood Protection Project. This closure will reduce eastbound traffic to one lane.

This stage of work will also require some night construction, which will include a 2-night closure of the Don Valley Parkway on-ramp and a 2-night work period near the intersection of Broadview and Eastern. This work will also include a two-night closure of the Don Valley Parkway on-ramp. There may be some overnight noise due to construction but our teams will be frequently monitoring for exceedances. Paid Duty Officers will be on site to manage traffic during this time. All other works will be conducted during standard, permitted hours (7 am – 7pm, Monday to Friday).

There will also be some permit-approved tree and shrub removals taking place this fall. This work is required to facilitate the utility relocation and the flood protection landform construction. Work will occur on the southwest side of the Don Valley Parkway on-ramp clover, in select areas north of Eastern Avenue, and along the north side of Sunlight Park Road.

We understand that construction has a real impact on people's everyday lives. To help you plan, we're sharing information early and will provide updates as we finalize details of when this construction will commence, our team is committed to keeping the community informed and will share confirmed dates and exact staging locations as soon as they are available.

About Broadview and Eastern Flood Protection Project

This project will provide flood protection to an area It will address the critical need for flood protection infrastructure to improve long-term resilience and stormwater management in the area. It will also allow for the future Broadview Avenue extension.

Waterfront Toronto and PCL are working in close coordination with the ongoing City of Toronto Adelaide & Eastern Bridges Rehabilitation Project to minimize impacts and disruption to residents and local traffic.
