- Waterfront Toronto is delivering the Procurement Process and will manage the design and construction of York Street Park
- The design competition winning design was announced on October 9<sup>th</sup> and Love Park by Claude Cormier et Associés was chosen as the winning design for York Street Park.
- The project is scheduled to start construction in 2019 with a construction budget of \$7 million


### **Jury Report:**

The Jury appreciated the simple and timeless nature of the design and agreed that its natural elements and elegant forms created a contemporary and inviting space for visitors.

The Jury recommended that the following be considered in the development of the design:

- Animate the water feature with year-round uses (e.g. potential model boating in summer & recreational skating in winter).
- Remove the pavilion to create more space for picnic tables and/or public gatherings.
   Accommodate mechanical uses above ground with any other interior uses in a smaller structure.
- Consider reducing the size of water element to create more gathering space.
- Add tables and chairs for eating.
- Increase the tree canopy considerably.
- Include sustainability features such as bioswales and integrated stormwater management approaches, and demonstrate the resilience of the park design to flooding.







(P15) Parks in the Central Waterfront will be diverse, well maintained, animated and safe, accommodating a full range of recreational experiences from areas for active play, enjoyment of sports and entertainment to areas for quiet solitude and relaxation. These experiences will be provided in a comfortable setting during all seasons of the year.

(P17) Sustainable management practices and design and construction techniques that have minimal environmental impacts and return the greatest ecological rewards will be utilized in waterfront parks.

(P31) Excellence in the design of public and private buildings, infrastructure (streets, bridges, promenades, etc.), parks and public spaces will be promoted to achieve quality, beauty and worldwide recognition.

(P35) Local parks will enrich new waterfront communities. Parks planning will take into account such factors as park size, land availability, neighbourhood accessibility, safety and quality of experience in park spaces

(P37) Public spaces, parks, transportation facilities and other public and private buildings in the Central Waterfront will be designed to ensure accessibility to persons with disabilities.
















