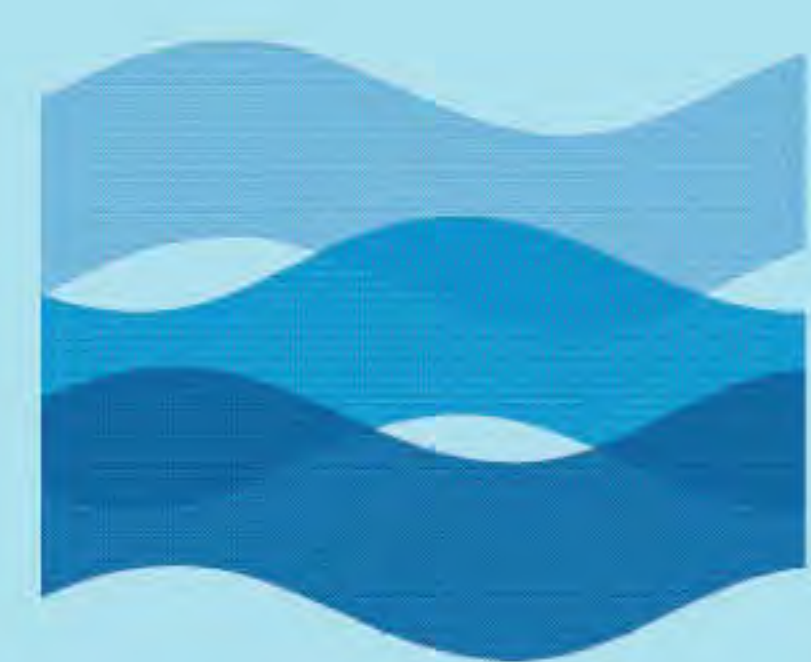
Cyclist Detour

Transforming Queens Quay

Construction is underway to revitalize Queens Quay from west of Lower Spadina Ave to east of Bay St. When complete in early 2015, Queens Quay will feature a new stretch of Martin Goodman Trail, giving cyclists a much needed connection through the Central Waterfront.

Detour Route

During construction, a detour bike route (see map) will enable cyclists to bypass most of the construction area. The detour bike route is an asphalt trail located in the boulevard area on the south side of Lake Shore Blvd W between Lower Spadina Ave and York St. Cyclists may use this route for either eastbound or westbound travel. Westbound cyclists may ride alongside vehicular traffic through the construction zone on Queens Quay but are encouraged to use the detour route when possible.



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
