

Guidance for the near, medium + longer terms so that we know what to expect tomorrow, but also to provide flexibility for what is yet to come










PORT LANDS PLANNING FRAMEWORK

Purpose:

- To guide revitalization + redevelopment over the long-term
- To provide more robust direction than is currently in the Central Waterfront Secondary Plan
- To integrate other initiatives DMNP EA and LDL EA
- To ensure that public and private investments contribute to the long-term vision and have lasting value
- To resolved outstanding appeals at the Ontario Municipal Board








PORT LANDS PLANNING FRAMEWORK

LAND USE + URBAN STRUCTURE












PORT LANDS + SOUTH OF EASTERN TRANSPORTATION + SERVICING MASTER PLAN












POPULATION + EMPLOYMENT ESTIMATES

- Report to Council in Spring 2016 with statutory public meetings




