Terms of References Transit Project in the Eastern Waterfront (East Bayfront, West Don Lands and Port Lands)

The Toronto Transit Commission (TTC), in association with the Toronto Waterfront Revitalization Corporation (TWRC) and the City of Toronto, is working on Environmental Assessment (EA) Studies that will identify a preferred approach to provide an effective transit network to serve the new waterfront communities comprised of the West Don Lands, East Bayfront and Port Lands precincts. The proposed transit projects will be essential to achieve TWRC and the City's planning objectives for the waterfront area. The TTC, as proponent, is seeking to conduct three EAs (one for each precinct). As part of the environmental assessment process the TTC is submitting three Terms of References (ToR) to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) for formal review as required under the provincial *Environmental Assessment Act*. If approved, the ToRs will serve as a benchmark for the preparation and review of the environmental assessment documents for these undertaking.
