Waterfront Toronto in partnership with the City of Toronto is currently undertaking an environmental assessment for the revitalization of Queens Quay Boulevard from Lower Spadina Avenue to Lower Jarvis Street. This study is exploring how to implement long standing City policy objectives including revitalizing Queens Quay into a scenic waterfront drive and completing the Martin Goodman Trail which today is absent through the central waterfront.

The project team, along with the City of Toronto and Toronto Transit Commission have been developing design alternatives for the cross-section of the street and collaboratively design alternatives have been developed.

We are interested in hearing your views and want to keep you informed about this project. Waterfront Toronto will be holding a public meeting on Dec. 8 to present the design alternatives. Please join us for the second public forum.
