QUEENS QUAY REVITALIZATION ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT: Opportunities to Participate Going Forward

Since the Queens Quay Revitalization EA began in September 2007, there has been extensive public consultation, including 5 meetings of the project's Stakeholder Advisory Committee; 3 public forums (including tonight's meeting); and multiple meetings with organizations and individuals with an interest in a revitalized Queens Quay corridor.

Although the EA has reached the stage where preferred alternatives are being recommended, there are multiple ways to participate going forward:

City of Toronto Council Meeting It is anticipated that Toronto Council will consider the Queens Quay project at its July meeting.	July 6, 2009
Notice of Study Completion Waterfront Toronto will publish a notice that the Queens Quay EA has been completed, and that the project report will be available for a 30-day comment period. Waterfront Toronto and the City of Toronto will endeavour to address concerns raised during the comment period.	Mid-August 2009
Part II Order Request If concerns regarding the project cannot be resolved in discussion with Waterfront Toronto and the City of Toronto during the 30-day comment period, a person may request the Minister of the Environment to make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (a Part II Order). A Part II Order requires a proponent to embark upon an individual Environmental Assessment.

Detailed Design If the project is approved, Waterfront Toronto will continue	Fall 2009 – Spring 2010
