- Welcome and Project Update
 Chris Barre welcomed the participants and gave a brief project update.
- 2. Construction Update

Anthony Bisanti provided an overview of construction activities:

- Excavation is now completed and construction has started.
- Completion of concrete is expected for the end of January 2012, followed by interim surface treatment which the Harboufront Centre will use as programmable space.

• Slab on grade will be completed by the end of the week, followed by saw cutting, which must be done within a 12-24 hour period (likely Friday afternoon).

3. Issues

- Since the last CLC meeting, the following incidents were noted and subsequently resolved:
 - a) Dust and lighting issues mentioned by Bonnie Miethig.
- Over the next few months, concrete trucks are expected to be the biggest nuisance.
- CLC members have requested that Ellis Don send the construction notice/updates with more than a 24 hour notice.
- Simon pointed out that community members should not communicate their concerns to the flagman due to the long delay in delivering those messages to the appropriate parties.
