### **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #2: IN-WATER PIPES IN EAST BAYFRONT**

### **Background**

Waterfront Toronto has begun work on the final piece of a large Stormwater Management System that services East Bayfront, the West Don Lands and future communities north of the Keating Channel.

The final piece includes construction of in-water pipes along the section of the Water's Edge Promenade spanning the foot of Sherbourne Common from approximately Dockside Drive to the southern point of 15 Merchants' Wharf, also known as the Aqualina at Bayside condos. When complete, the in-water pipes will help convey stormwater to the Cherry Street Stormwater Management Facility where it will be treated to remove pollutants before the water flows to Lake Ontario.

### **Updates:**

## **Construction Fencing**

Fast fencing has been installed along 160 metres of the Promenade affected by this work as well as tree protection around the affected trees on the southern side of the Promenade. This will temporarily obstruct views of the lake from Sherbourne Common and reduce the width of the Promenade.

### **Canada Day Holiday Construction**

On July 1, 2021 (Canada Day), our contractor, Clearway, will be undertaking preliminary work for the inwater pipes between the hours of 7am-7pm, including formwork and installing a floating barrier to prevent the spread of sediment in the lake while work is underway. This work will take place from the waterside of the Water's Edge Promenade and vessels will be present on the water. No work will be taking place on July 2, 2021.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Moderate noise should be expected.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will still have access to the full length of the WEP during this time.
- There are no anticipated impacts to parking or traffic in the area.

# **Tree Pruning**

Arborists will be undertaking tree pruning in preparation for construction to remove dead limbs from the trees that are within the affected area on the Promenade. This work helps to ensure the health and longevity of these trees before, during and after construction.

## Timeline

Construction is expected to be completed by June 2022.
