

Public Forum: Marine Strategies

The Toronto Waterfront Revitalization Corporation (TWRC) invites you to attend a public meeting to review the draft final marine strategy study. The marine strategy study process was begun in 2005 with the goal of ensuring that the activities and requirements of marine users on the Toronto waterfront are integrated into the revitalization work that the TWRC is carrying out. The study process has included extensive consultation with a wide range of marine users.

This public meeting will provide stakeholders with an opportunity to review:

- The core themes and principles that comprise the marine strategy
- Ideas to foster the implementation of the strategy
- Conclusions of the stakeholder consultation process
- Results of the research on current and future needs for marine facilities

The study includes a primary document that describes the marine use strategy, as well as a detailed resource guide with maps that summarizes the supporting information gathered throughout the course of the study. All of these documents are available for downloading at www.towaterfront.ca
