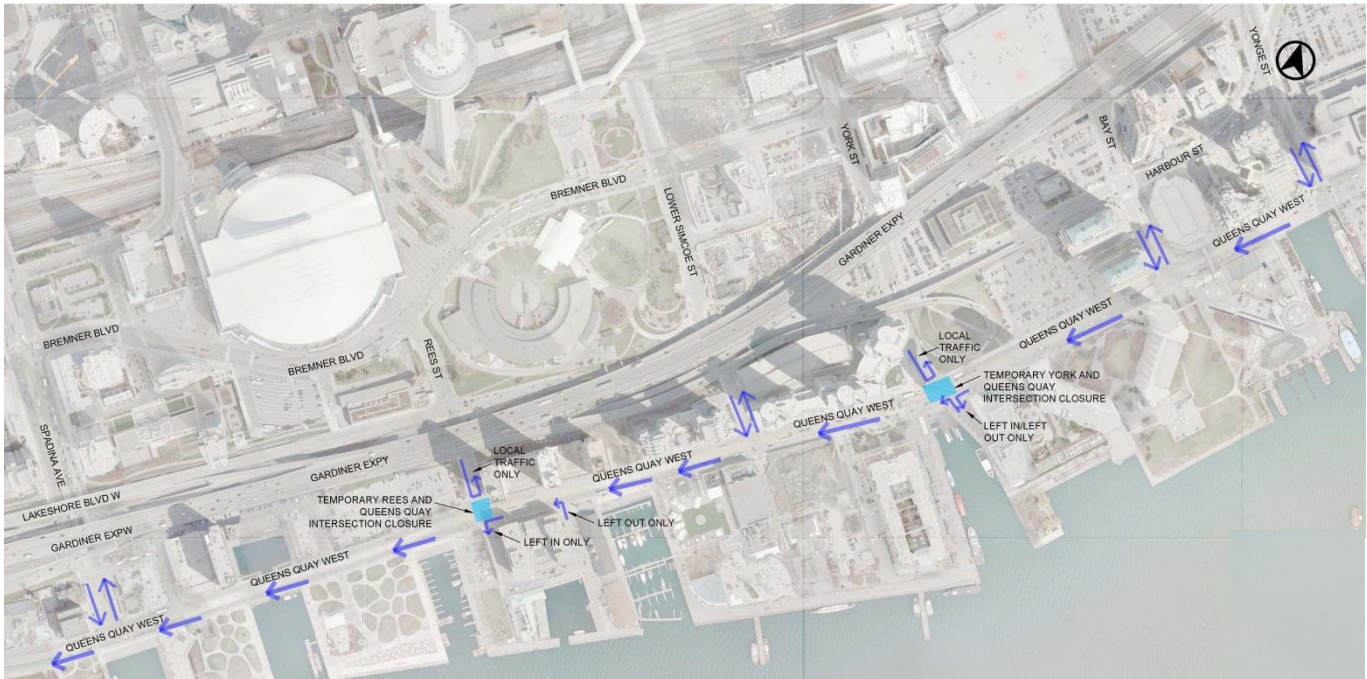


ADVANCE NOTICE: QUEENS QUAY CONSTRUCTION

Upcoming Partial Intersection Closures: York Street and Rees Street

The York and Rees intersections will be partially closed starting June 2 for the rebuild of the TTC streetcar corridor. York Street will be closed on June 2 followed by Rees Street mid-week. Westbound traffic on Queens Quay will be maintained through the intersections. During this work, vehicles will not be permitted to travel northbound onto York St or Rees St from Queens Quay. There will also be no southbound access to Queens Quay from York St or Rees St.



A safe north/south pedestrian crossing will be created on the west side of each intersection during this period. TTC stops will also be located on the west side of the intersection.

Local Access:

- **York St (south of Harbour):** Will remain open for local traffic including coaches parking in the York St parking lay-by. Paid duty officers will help direct traffic. There will be no thru traffic access to Queens Quay from York St.
- **Rees St (south of Harbour):** Will remain open to local traffic including the parking garage for 250/260/270 Queens Quay. The temporary parking laybys will also be available. There will be no thru traffic access to Queens Quay from Rees St. A safe north/south pedestrian crossing will be created west of the intersection.
- **One York Quay:** Northbound and southbound access to 77/99 Harbour Square from York St will not be available during this work. Vehicles must enter from Queens Quay via Bay St. Harbour Square residents may also use the service laneway on the south side of the building which exits onto Bay St.
- **York Slip Laneway:** Access will remain open. Vehicles must enter from Queens Quay via Bay Street.
- **Robertson Crescent:** Will remain open in its current one-way configuration with access from Queens Quay only. Vehicles traveling westbound on Queens Quay enter at the west leg of Robertson Crescent (and exit from the east leg). Southbound access to Robertson Crescent from Rees Street will not be available.
